GOLF ON THE CAJUN COAST

Enjoy Louisiana's most unique golf experiences on the Cajun Coast!

Day One and Two:

The Atchafalaya Golf Course at Idlewild is surrounded by the rich wildlife and incredible beauty found only in the heart of the Atchafalaya Basin. Designed by von Hagge, Smelek and Baril, the 7,533-yard course contains five lakes and ten native wetland areas that encompass nearly 40 acres of this 175-acre layout. More than a half million yards of native soil were used to develop dramatic elevations and breathtaking vistas.

Designer Robert von Hagge is well known for his innovative courses including Doral, LaCosta and TPC at the Woodlands. The 18-hole course features five sets of tees—each named after wildlife native to the basin—large fairways and generous pin placements. The course also includes a complete practice facility. The raised Acadian-style cottage clubhouse opened in 2007.

Day Three: LaTour Golf Club - 45 minutes from Morgan City

LaTour Golf Club is located deep in the heart of Bayou Country. Nestled along the banks of beautiful Bayou Lafourche, LaTour features an 18-hole golf course designed by PGA tour champion David Toms. The 72-par course sits on 597 acres of beautiful rolling grasslands and lakes that add to the beauty and splendor of LaTour.

The 7,232-yard championship layout, immaculate greens, abundant water, pure white sand traps, and 75 acres of native grass area is a challenge and delight for every golfer. LaTour offers four teeing areas for each hole appealing to golfers of all skill levels. As well as the championship course, golfers can enjoy the fully stocked golf pro shop, driving range, and practice putting and chipping greens. Also on-site is LaTour Bar & Grill which offers delicious cuisine to be enjoyed by family and friends or as fitting compliment after a round of golf. We welcome you to LaTour!

Day Four: The Wetlands Golf Club, 73 miles from Morgan City

The Wetlands Golf Club is Lafayette's newest golf course. Opened in April 2006, this course was designed by

architect Frank Burandt. The course not only showcases the region's many lakes and wetland areas, it also features abundant native grasses and wildflowers. The challenge of the golf course presents itself with well-bunkered greens and water hazards that affect 11 of its 18 holes.

The Wetlands accommodates all levels of players with five tees ranging from 7,300 yards at the longest and just over 5,000 yards at the shortest. The TifDwarf© greens are smooth rolling, providing a test for every golfer. Wind is a factor on this golf course's #9 and #18 holes, which feature a double green that ends at the clubhouse for dramatic finishes.

Day Five: TPC Louisiana, 71 miles from Morgan City

TPC Louisiana brings world-class, daily-fee golf to New Orleans and The Audubon Golf Trail. Working in conjunction with PGA TOUR players Steve Elkington and Louisiana native Kelly Gibson, master architect Pete Dye created a 7,425 yard, par-72 championship course that is carved out of the South Louisiana forest that utilizes natural vegetation, water features inhabited by native alligators and numerous cypress trees. Many compare it to a private nature preserve.

The course offers five sets of tees, and even though the course stretches to 7,425 yards from the championship tees, Dye is pleased about a collection of short but challenging par-4 holes that complement the longer ones. Located just 15 minutes from the French Quarter, TPC Louisiana is the home of Louisiana's only PGA TOUR event, the Zurich Classic of New Orleans.
